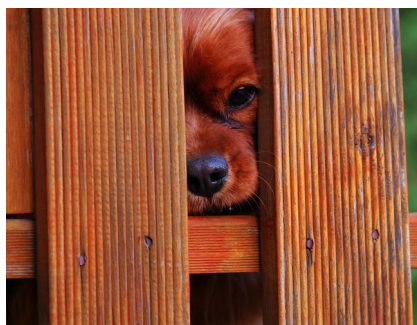

Spring - Snakes and Dogs

With the start of Spring, snakes are beginning to emerge from their winter hibernation. They can pose a serious threat to our friendly and often nosy pets in parklands, around waterways and on rural and urban properties alike.

Signs of snake bite in dogs:

- ◆ Sudden weakness and subsequent collapse
- ◆ Obvious pain and discomfort
- ◆ Vomiting
- ◆ Loss of bladder and bowel control
- ◆ Swelling and bleeding at the bite site



If you suspect your dog has been bitten seek help from your vet immediately.

If you are unable to get your dog to a vet immediately, apply a pressure bandage around the site as this can help slow the spread of the venom.

Vera is one of our special ex-breeding girls who is now ready for life with a family full of cuddles and love.

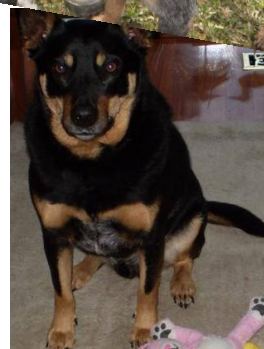
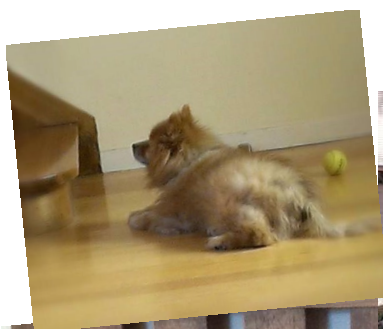
